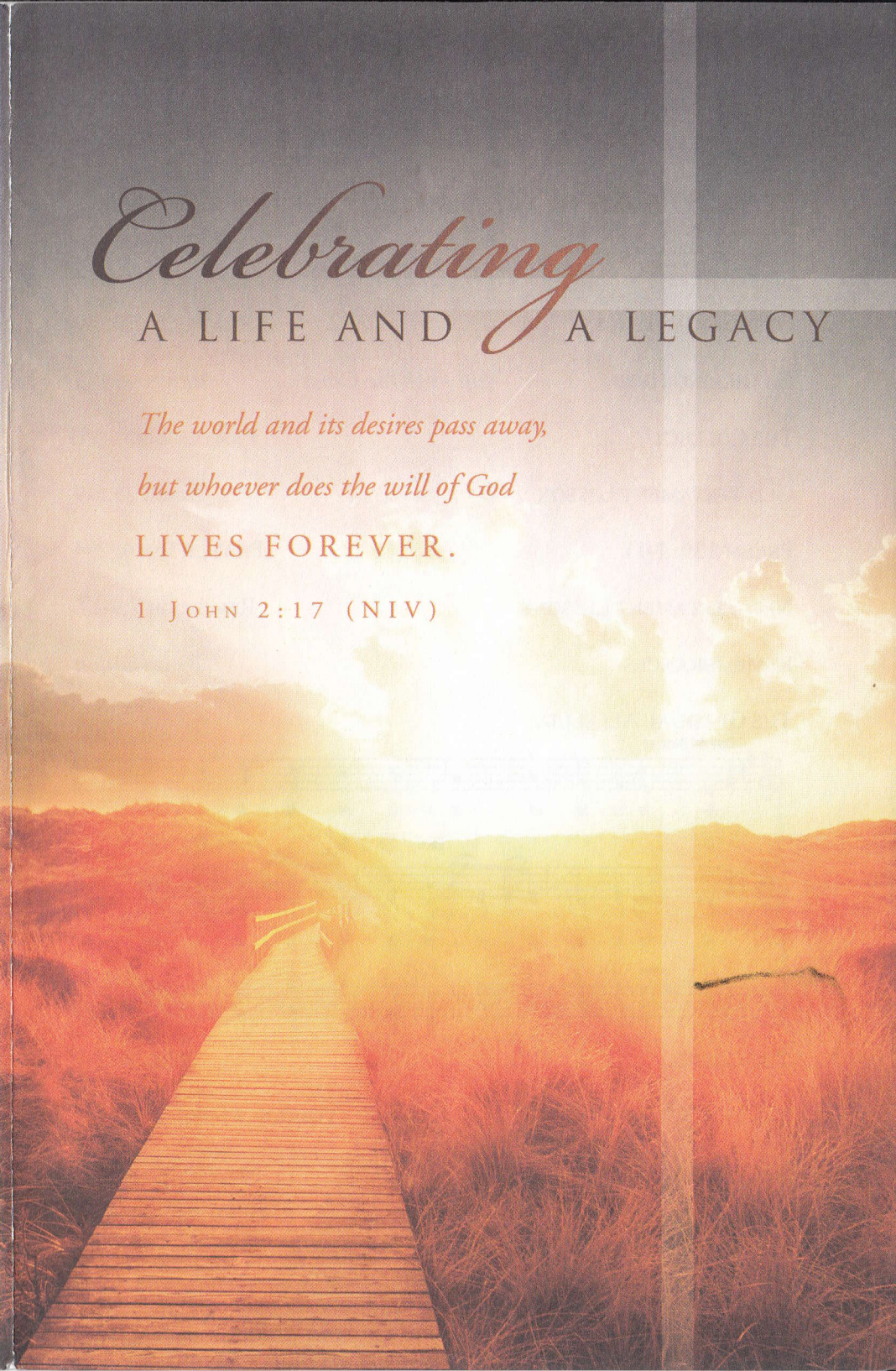



If you prefer to receive only the Bread or only the Wine as full communion, you may indicate so by crossing your arms over your chest at the appropriate time. If you would like Communion but are unable to come forward, please advise an usher and we will come to you. If it is not your custom to receive Communion, you are invited to come forward with everyone for a prayer or a blessing. Simply cross your arms over your chest and the clergy will give you a blessing or prayer. This is God's table, not ours, and you are all very welcome here.</i></p>
